

Materials:

- Ameroclassic wavy letter opener kit 626, 1426
- Pen blank, minimum size 5/8" x 2-3/4"
- 3) 21/64" drill bit 174
- Maxi-cure Extra-thick CA 184, polyurethane 196, or epoxy 189
- 5) 5/8" barrel facing tool 331 with pilot 334
- Ameroclassic mandrel and bushing set 326
- Sanding rolls, 4 pk. 1120
- 7) HUT PPP combo 109 or Hut Crystal Coat 104

Blank Preparation:

- Cut blank approximately 1/4" longer than its respective tube.
- Drill blank with a 21/64" drill bit.
- 3) Glue tube into blank.
- When glue is cured, square ends with barrel facing tool.
- 5) Turn on an Ameroclassic mandrel with bushing set 326 (you only need to use the 2 larger diameter cap bushings). Arrange bushings as shown (Fig. 1). Fill excess mandrel space with extra bushings.

Turning:

- Turn blank down to the bushings. The barrel should have the typical straight Ameroclassic profile.
- Using a parting tool, remove 3/16" of material down to brass tube on the center ring end of barrel. (Fig. 3) Make sure all glue is off brass.



4) Sand and finish with HUT PPP combo. Finish with a two-step process; first apply PPP Satin Gloss, then PPP High gloss for a perfect pen polish!

Assembly:

- Assemble three-piece center ring as shown (Fig. 2).
 Slide center ring onto hilt shaft, tapered end first.
 Press hilt into exposed end of brass tube. The center ring should fit over 1/8" of exposed brass tube.
- Place small gold ring on finial.
- Push finial with gold ring into top of barrel.
- Screw blade into hilt.
